Written Test for Assessment of Subject Knowledge:

- (1) The question paper will be of 2 hours duration and maximum marks will be 100. There will be no negative marks for wrong answer. For qualifying written test a candidate should obtain at least 50% marks (minimum qualifying marks \geq 50).
- (2) The question paper will be based on syllabus of GATE examination in Engineering & Technology Discipline. The question paper will be based on syllabus of CSIR-UGC, NET examination in Applied Sciences & Humanities Discipline.
- (3) The question paper will have the following types of question and marking scheme:
 - (i) Multiple choice objective types (4 choices- A, B, C & D) questions. Total number of questions will be 42 of 2 marks each.
 - (ii) Short Answer Type questions (25-50 words). Total number of questions will be 03 of 03 marks each.
 - (iii) Descriptive Type questions (75-100 words). Only one question that will be of 7 marks.
- (4) The marks obtained by a candidate in written test will be converted from 100 marks to 40 marks for assessment for domain knowledge through written test.

For each post five candidates will be called for interview in order of merit based on marks obtained in 10.B –(I+II) in each specific post.
